Eyota Township Culvert Installation Policy

Purpose:

This policy defines the Township of Eyota's Policy for installation of new culverts and the moving of a culvert.

Policy:

All changes/modifications to an existing or new driveway must have prior written approval from the Township of Eyota. Applications should include a description of the work to be done, including, if required, any engineering. Engineering will be at owners expense.

All work must be performed by either the township or a qualified installer. If a qualified installer is to be used, proof of insurance must be included with the application.

Culverts may be purchased through the township. If purchased elsewhere specifications of the culvert must be included with the application.

New Driveway access:

Culverts for new access to township roads (new residences) will be provided and installed at township expense. Standard length will be 28 Ft. Will include aprons if required. Unique situations will be addressed on an individual basis.

Deteriorated culverts:

Culverts that have deteriorated through normal weather (wear and tear) will be replaced at township expense. Damaged culverts will be assessed to determine cause. The responsibility for cost of replacement and/or repair will be determined on an individual basis prior to replacement.

Existing and/or additional Driveways:

Moving, widening and/or adding a drive to a piece of property must have prior approval from the Township of Eyota. All expenses will be the responsibility of the landowner.

Blocked or Plugged culverts

Blocked or plugged culverts should be reported immediately to the township.

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
