Eyota Township Work within the ROW

Purpose: Eyota Township's Board of Supervisors is the road authority for the Township. The Right of Way (ROW) of all roads is 66 feet wide. This policy addresses requirements before work can be performed within the ROW.

Policy: A person or company intending to perform any construction, repairs, rehabilitation, or improvements within the ROW must receive written approval from the Board prior to beginning work. The following items are required with the request: 1. A plan of the work to be performed; 2. proof of insurance in the amount of \$1.5 million (Minn. Stat. 466.04, subd.1(a)(3) & (7). Work cannot begin prior to approval.

Contractors using employees must complete and submit an IC-134 form to the township before receiving final payment.

Utility Poles: Placement of utility poles shall be placed at the back of the ROW. Variations must be approved by the Board.

Buried utilities & Cable Installation: Buried cables are to be installed either at the back of the ROW, or the front edge of the ditch along road surface. Nothing is to be buried in the bottom of the ditch.

Above ground equipment must be located at the back of the ROW. Exceptions must be approved by the Board.

Driveways and Field Drives: Refer to the policies posted on our website. Eyotatownship.com

General Road Maintenance: Grading and chloride applications are the responsibility of the Board. Report issues to the Board.
