Opening

The regular meeting of the Eyota Township Board was called to order at 7 pm on May 18, 2020 at the Eyota Ambulance Barn by D O'Neill.

Approval of Minutes

Minutes March 16th Meeting, Minutes of Equalization meeting April 14th, and April 20th meeting were reviewed and approved.

Treasurer Report

Stand as read. General Fund: \$10,810.15 Road and Bridge \$122,498.17, Fire \$51,572.96, Fire Mutual Fund \$73,216.43.

Open Issues

Fire Department has nothing new to report per B Halvorson.

54th St SE near Schoenfelder Farms discussed with M Brass. Township request that Schoenfelder farms and/or employees contact township with road concerns with a contact card given to M Brass.

Road Rocking recommendations shared by D O'Neill with township map. Road rocking will not occur until into June as quarry does not have Cat 5 rock available r/t a crusher. Work on intersection of 125th Ave & 40th St SE complete with signs to be placed. Mueller drive widening on 90th street complete. Hammel new field drive on 10th street on schedule to be done.

Request for a field drive in section 36 off 54th St approved with installation to be done by landowner as has appropriate insurance. Due to HWY 14 closure, increased traffic on township roads has led to increased dust. Chloride was applied to 10th street and 100th Ave. Regular chloride application scheduled for May 26th. D O'Neill reports that some of the soft spots from last year do not look so bad, and that new ones have developed, so will continue to monitor. Some signs and/or post were taken by persons unknown and replaced by the county.

FEMA and the Soft Spot "Frost Boil" Olmsted County in Disaster Declaration 4442 follow up given by D O'Neill with no word in the last month.

Fall Elections may be a challenge related to COVID-19. Olmsted Election officials are looking into options.

Board approved mailing invoice to D Brandt for additional chloride application.

Clerk shared that after contacting new owner Bluff Country Reader, now Filmore County News, that mailings will not occur in Eyota township. Emails received concerning Compost facility Siting, and EC Agenda Packet shared. Olmsted County trade report from March and April reviewed.

Motion to pay bills totaling \$4486.78 made by B Halvorson, seconded by J Schumann, motion passed with all in favor.
