The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance

The Clerk's Report was reviewed and approved.

The treasurer's report was presented. The report states as presented.

Fire department Issues:

a. The sale of the old fire truck number 5 was not completed. The buyer backed out on the deal. The department has not made a decision regarding what to do with the truck given efforts to sell it have not been failed.

b. Brian Halvorson informed the board the fire department is working toward establishing charitable gambling. The proceeds will be invested for the purchase of a new truck when the need arises.

Clerk Position:

Mr. O'Neill informed the board Mr. Mason will not be available for the remainder of meeting until his term ends in March 2018. Mr. Mason has not resigned. Mr. Hammel, deputy clerk, has agreed to cover the position until the election, thus giving interested candidates the opportunity to file for the position.

MAT State Meeting:

The annual meeting of MAT was held in Rochester November 16 thru 18. Mr. O'Neill reported on the meeting. Water quality was the theme of the meeting. Mr. O'Neill noted the discussion of chloride (Salt) impact on the water quality. He recommended the board investigate alternative sources for dust control. He will look into these options further.

Township road issues:

Mr. O'Neill reported on the septic testing currently being carried out by Olmsted County.

Mr. O'Neill reported a sink hole on 10th St was discovered and has been repaired.

10th St west has become a dumping ground for tires. Mr. O'Neill delivered 9 tires plus a freezer picked up on 10th St. Mr. Kullot noted there are more tires on that stretch of road plus what he has picked up and is keeping at his residence until they can be taken to the county recycling site.

Mr. schumann reported the county is looking into the residence where there are concerns of stockpiling trash.

Bills:

The board approved and paid bills totaling \$5736.55

Meeting was adjourned at 7:40 PM.
